Anyone who walks on West Portal or has seen the sidewalk encampments on other streets knows the situation doesn't seem to be improving. What can we do to help people get off the street? • Update on Proposed Housing at 250 Laguna Honda – Dave Woo, from the Forest Hill Association, will give us a brief update on the project proposed on the site of the Forest Hill Christian Church. • Motion to Formally Oppose the Blending of Groundwater with Hetch Hetchy Water – Last month, the SF PUC presented information about the blending of groundwater with Hetch Hetchy water to be distributed on the western side of SF. The PUC says the blended water will be safe, but some are concerned that the quality will be degraded. The question is whether WTPCC should write a letter opposing blended water to present at a Board of Supervisors hearing on the plan two days later.
