AMENDMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE CODE Chapter 31
[Board File No. 061311]**

Dear President Alexander:

On October 23, 2006 the West of Twin Peaks Central Council, representing sixteen Westside neighborhood organizations voted to request a continuance of the hearing on the aforementioned matter. The reaction of the assembled majority was to request a hearing continuance from the Planning Commission in order to ensure adequate time for thorough review of significant legislation.

A representative of the Council has dire concerns regarding the process and notice of the proposed amendments to Administrative Code Chapter 31. Those voting concurred based on the following concerns:

- Notice of the Planning Commission's 10/19/06 hearing on the matter was not published in an official newspaper as required.
- The West of Twin Peaks Central Council did not receive a mailed notice on the matter.
- No materials regarding the matter are available to the public in the 10/26/06 hearing file.
- Administrative Code 31 provides **no revision, and/or modification, thereto** can be undertaken **absent public hearing and resolution by the Planning Commission**; notice for such hearing **"shall be...at least" twenty (20) days prior** to such hearing [Adm. Code Chapter 31, Sec. 31.04(a) through(c) and 31.05(h)].

Furthermore, additional amendments to the legislation were submitted at the October 19 hearing and are to be considered at the October 26, 2006 meeting. We are familiar with those amendments and thereby request a continuance of 30 days in order to have necessary time to review and respond to the legislation and proposed amendments to Chapter 31 of the San Francisco Administrative Code.
