**Featured Speakers:** Planning Commissioner Michael Antonini said that the Eastern Neighborhood Plan is going back to the Commission with changes. The Commission is also discussing the rebuild of the Hetch Hetchy water system. A Whole Foods Store will be built at Haight and Stanyan with housing over the store. Michael Antonini said the neighbors support the project. A reform of the Discretionary Review process is now in progress. Two candidates presented their qualifications for District 7 Supervisor: Julian Lagos, former High School Teacher, and Billy Bob Whitmer, Educator and Businessman. Sean Elsbernd, the incumbent, was unable to attend.
