Land Use and Planning: Denise LaPointe announced that the BOS Land Use Committee will hear the Discretionary Review Reform on 3/8/10 and suggested people attend and voice views.

Traffic and Safety Avrum Shepard announced that the Coalition of San Francisco Neighborhood is one of the sponsor of a MUNI summit to be held on 3/6/10 at the Women's Bldg from 8:15 to 1:00. It will not be run by MUNI. Regarding **Roger Ritter's** request that WTPCC study the dangers of U-Turns on West Portal Avenue intersections, **George Wooding** determined that there was not enough support from neighborhood associations to warrant any further action . **Avrum Shepard** announced that the SFMTA was presenting the 19th Avenue Corridor Study at a public meeting on February 24, with the deadline for public comment on February 26. **Marilyn Amini** suggested that WTPCC write a letter requesting a 45 day continuance for public comment. **Denise LaPointe moved that WTPCC support Marilyn and Paul Conroy seconded the motion that passed unanimously.**

Health: **George Wooding** announced that behavioral health patients are being admitted back into Laguna Honda despite the lack of a psych license.

Delegate Report: **Avrum Shepard** reported that DPW gave a presentation to GWPNA regarding the tagging of sidewalks that need repair on West Portal Avenue and nearby neighborhoods. DPW reportedly will charge \$10.00 a square to replace. **George Wooding** suggested they speak to WTPCC.

New Business: **Don Dutil** proposed that WTPCC oppose the conditional request for a Cannabis Club on Taraval Street. **Denise LaPointe moved that WTPCC write a letter in opposition. Roger Ritter seconded the motion that passed unanimously Eliot Wagner** of the West Portal Avenue Association invited WTPCC delegates to attend their meeting on 3/17/10

Featured Speakers: **Steve Kawa** discussed problems with the City budget deficit. **John Rizzo** discussed the \$20 million shortfall in the CCSF budget and capital improvement problems.
